Morton Grove Fire Department – Minimum Requirements

APPLICATION DEADLINE: AUGUST 28, 2018 AT 4:00 PM

Below are the requirements for the MORTON GROVE FIRE DEPARTMENT:

- \$65 non-refundable application fee (one \$65 fee will grant you access to all four departments);
- High School Diploma or equivalent (GED);
- 21 to <u>under</u> 35 years of age by date of written exam (September 29, 2018), unless otherwise exempt by state statute;
- U.S. Citizen or an alien admitted for permanent residence or lawfully admitted for temporary residence and who produces evidence of intention to become a citizen of the U.S.;
- Valid driver's license;
- Must have successfully completed the Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) and Aerial Ladder Climb Exercise within a ONE YEAR PERIOD prior to the date of the written exam (September 29, 2018)
 - Applicants who have not taken the CPAT test and Aerial Ladder Climb Exercise between 09.29.17 and 09.29.18 must obtain certificate of completion from one of the following licensed agencies:

- Vision: 20/30 corrected, 20/100 uncorrected, able to identify/distinguish between red, green and yellow
- In order to complete the probationary period, candidates must have obtained Illinois State Basic Operations Firefighter Certification and Illinois EMT-Paramedic Certification.

Preference Point Information:

Based on the rules of the Morton Grove Board of Fire and Police Commissioners, the following preference points will be awarded:

Category	Criteria for Award	Max. Pts.
Veteran Status	 At least one year of active service in the military service of the United States (i.e. Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard). Honorable discharge or current active/inactive reserve status. Verified DD-214 or proof of current reserve status. 	5 pts.
Educational Status	 Associate's Degree from an accredited college/university in the field of Fire Science or Emergency Medical Services (EMS) = (2 points) Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college/university in any field of study = (4 points) Verified by a copy of the diploma and certified copy of transcripts 	4 pts. max. (not cumulative)
Background/Skills	 Min. of 2 years of employment in an occupation considered to be "traderelated" and have practical application to the fire service (i.e. carpenter, electrician, plumber, laborer, automotive/vehicle technician (mechanic), etc.) = (2 points) - Demonstrated by verifiable and applicable work history. Demonstrated fluency in verbal communication of a foreign language. = (2 points) - Demonstrated by verified demonstration. 	2 pts.
