Borough of Naugatuck Agency Profile

The Borough of Naugatuck Fire Department is a career department which protects a mix of residential, commercial and light industrial occupancies.

The NFD operates out of two stations with a full time staff of 42.

All members except the Chief and Deputy Chief and Fire Marshal are represented by I.A.F.F. Local 1219. There are 4 shifts of 8 firefighters and 1 dispatcher working a 24/72 shift schedule.

The NFD responds to 1,000-1,500 calls per year and does not provide emergency medical services.

All new firefighters must attend and successfully complete the Connecticut Fire Academy Recruit Program unless they have graduated from the program within the last five (5) years of appointment.

Minimum qualifications:

- Must have a High School Diploma or G.E.D.
- Possess a valid CT Driver's License (CDL or Q highly desired).
- Must have a current EMT License.
- Must be a U.S. Citizen.
- Must be at least 21 years old at time of conditional job offer.
- Possess a valid (not older than 1 year) CPAT card at the time of conditional job offer.
- Candidate must successfully complete and pass a thorough background investigation and post- offer medical examination including drug & alcohol screening.
- Live within a 25 minute response time.
