North Haven Fire Department

Minimum Requirements:

- Be a minimum of 18 years of age
- Be a citizen of the United States
- Live within a 30 mile radius of North Haven Fire Headquarters in accordance with CBA
- Must have EMT-Paramedic license (National Registry) and/or have already obtained medical control with Yale New Haven Sponsor Hospital. Candidate will obtain YNHSH medical control within 12 months of hire date and maintain in accordance with CBA as a condition of employment. Candidate may be an NREMT-P student attending a CoAEMSP accredited program in good standing with 75% of course completion, although candidate must possess a FF1 certification.
- The Town reserves the right to give preference to paramedic candidates that are currently State Certified Firefighter 1 and graduates of the CT Fire Academy within the last five years.
- Must have passed and been certified by the Candidates Physical Ability Test (CPAT).
 Candidates without CPAT will need to obtain CPAT certification prior to conditional job offer.
- Be in general good health and have sufficient strength, stamina and agility to perform the duties required by the position
- Pass a written, oral, background and credit check, psychological screening, drug testing and physical examination
- Have no criminal record and possess excellent moral character
- Have graduated High School, OR possess a State of Connecticut High School Equivalency Certificate OR some other certificate recognized by the State equal to The GED
- Have normal hearing, normal color vision and depth perception, with no marked muscle imbalance.
- Visual acuity 20/20 to 20/40, corrected to 20/20
- Note: preference will be given to non-smokers
- Have a motor vehicle operator's license issued by the State of Connecticut
