### Wilmette Fire Department – Minimum Requirements

**APPLICATION DEADLINE: AUGUST 28, 2018 AT 4:00 PM**

#### Below are the requirements for the WILMETTE FIRE DEPARTMENT:

- \$65 non-refundable application fee (one \$65 fee will grant you access to all four departments);
- High School Diploma or equivalent (GED) **PLUS ONE** of the following:
  - Sixty (60) hours of education from an accredited college or university;
  - Two (2) years of military service;
  - Illinois State Fire Marshall's Firefighter II/Basic Operations Firefighter certification;
  - Current EMT - Paramedic license from any state or national registration;
- 21 to under 35 years of age by date of written exam (September 29, 2018), unless otherwise exempt by state statute;
- United States citizen or legally authorized to work in the United States;
- Valid driver's license;
- Must have successfully completed the Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) and Aerial Ladder Climb Exercise within a **ONE YEAR PERIOD** prior to the date of the written exam (September 29, 2018)
  - Applicants who have not taken the CPAT test and Aerial Ladder Climb Exercise between 09.29.17 and 09.29.18 must obtain certificate of completion from one of the following licensed agencies:

#### Preference Point Information:

Based on the rules of the Wilmette Board of Fire and Police Commissioners, the following preference points will be awarded (max. 15 points):

Category	Criteria for Award	Max. Pts.
Veteran Status	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• At least one year of active service in the military service of the United States (i.e. Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard).</li><li>• Honorable discharge or current active/inactive reserve status.</li><li>• Verified DD 214 or proof of current reserve status.</li></ul>	5 pts.
Paramedic License	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• State of Illinois <u>or</u> National Registry EMT-Paramedic certification.</li></ul>	5 pts.
Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Bachelor's degree or greater in any field.</li></ul>	5 pts.
