

Wilton Fire Department

About Wilton FD:

The Wilton Fire Department protects an area of approximately 26.8 square miles with a population of 18,000. Wilton has two station stops on the Danbury Branch of the Metro-North Railroad's New Haven Line, Wilton Center and Cannondale. Wilton is located about 50 miles (80 km) northeast of New York City.

The Wilton Fire Department provides 24-hour fire, rescue, emergency medical service, and hazardous material mitigation from two fire stations. Fire Headquarters is located at 236 Danbury Road (US 7) in the Town Hall Municipal Campus. Station 2 is located at 707 Ridgefield Road (CT RT. 33) in North Wilton. Both stations are staffed 24 hours a day by career Firefighter/EMT's.
