The Poquonnock Bridge Fire Department (PBFD) is a proud partner of the fire district town wide fire protection system of the Town of Groton, CT. We provide and receive assistance within a pre-incident planned partnership with all the fire districts serving the Town of Groton.

PBFDs primary mission is to provide public safety for the residents and visitors of the Poquonnock Bridge Fire District from all emergencies natural and manmade. Operating out of one station, staffed by four shifts of one captain and four firefighters that protect a population of 10,000 people. PBFD covers 12.16 square miles of residential neighborhoods, apartment buildings, condominium complexes, senior housing, rehabilitation facilities, commercial and industrial occupancies, five public schools, two state parks, the Groton New London Airport and nine miles of interstate 95.

Our dedicated firefighters and officers operate and maintain one front line engine and quint ladder truck, one spare engine, 16' inflatable boat and UTV. Non emergency services include fire education, prevention, inspection, investigation, maintains a municipal fire alarm system that provides fire alarm protection for over 150 businesses and municipal buildings. PBFD averages 755 hours of annual department wide training consisting of basic and advanced firefighting skills, Hazardous Material response, building construction, specialized rescue, officer development, fire code enforcement, fire investigation, incident command, emergency medical skills and active shooter medical response with regional training council and the Town of Groton Police Department.
