

Willimantic Fire Department

About Willimantic FD:

The Willimantic Fire Department provides primary fire suppression to the 4.5 square miles that is the Willimantic Taxing District (City of Willimantic), and transport BLS EMS to the entire Town of Windham and Town of Chaplin. The Town of Windham has a population of approximately 23,000 residents, most of whom reside in the City of Willimantic (nearly 18,000). The City of Willimantic is home to Eastern Connecticut State University and fifteen minutes south of the University of Connecticut campus in Storrs.

The Willimantic Fire Department provides 24/7 fire, rescue, and emergency medical services from a single fire station located at 13 Bank Street. The station is staffed 24 hours a day by 28 career Firefighter/EMTs.

Minimum Requirements:

- U.S Citizen or authorized to work in the United States
- High School diploma or GED
- Age 18 at time of application
- Valid Connecticut driver's license
- Ability to pass an occupational physical
- Ability to obtain CPAT certification prior to completion of probationary period. Failure to do so will result in immediate termination of employment.
- Ability to obtain EMT certification prior to completion of probationary period. Failure to do so will result in immediate termination of employment.
- All personnel must reside within 12 miles, in a straight line, of the fire station prior to completion of the probationary period. Failure to do so will result in immediate termination of employment.
