# LASALLE FIRE DEPARTMENT OVERVIEW



## **STAFFING**

The LaSalle Fire Department is a combination department, in the process of increasing staffing to 2 full time firefighters and 2 contract paramedics per shift. We have a compliment of POC firefighters and Part time EMT's as well.



## **COVERAGE AREA**

Our coverage area is 14 square miles and includes a mix of commercial, residential, and agricultural with 85 percent hydrant coverage.



## **SPECIAL OPERATIONS**

MABAS Division 25 deploys a HAZMAT and Technical Rescue team. Members of LaSalle Fire Department are encouraged to join and participate in these teams.



## **CALL VOLUME**

The LaSalle Fire Department responds to an average of 2400 calls per year. We are an all-hazards response organization with the duty of responding to and mitigating a variety of emergency and non-emergency incidents including but not limited to fires, field medical and trauma care, special hazards, and public service requests.
